Class A Member: Any company, organization, individual or government/regulator expressing an interest in the mission and purpose of IFAST, may apply to become a Class A member (refer to IFAST Bylaws). Corporations, agencies, or organizations shall assign a single representative to attend meetings and conduct business with IFAST on their behalf. Additional representatives may attend but will not receive the membership privileges as listed below. Applications are required and necessary to ensure the general membership population remains well balanced in interests and purpose. Applications will be reviewed for approval by the Board of Directors. Applications may be submitted at any time.

Membership Requirements: The company, organization, government/regulator or individual applying may represent a corporate, governmental, or single party interest. Companies, organizations and government/regulators may have multiple members however, only one may be designated as the voting member. Government/regulators are not entitled to a vote. To remain in active status, a member must be current in dues.

Privileges:

- Present motions to the chairman and address Members during general and special meetings;
- Participate in annual and special meeting discussions, present contributions, positions and recommendations;
- Vote on matters that come before the Members and participate in consensus and
- Have access to the Members Only portion of the website.
